ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

River City Rowing Club,

A CALIFORNIA NONPROFIT PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION

I

The name of this corporation is RIVER CITY ROWING CLUB.

II

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law of the State of California for charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are to provide educational rowing programs, safety training and instruction in aquatic activities for youngsters, rowing instruction for adults, and a recreational and competitive sweep rowing and sculling program for the benefit of all persons living or working in the greater Sacramento area.

III

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

V

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or

member thereof, or to the benefit of any private person. On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

VI

This corporation may indemnify its directors, officers, employees, and other agents to the fullest extent permitted by California law.
